Cashier

The Cashier is responsible for:

Handling cash, collecting payment and issuing change.

Main Duties of Cashier on the till.

-They will spend the majority of their time working on tills or cash registers, but also undertake some Lunchtime assistant tasks.

- Count money in cash drawers at the beginning and end of shift to ensure that amounts are correct and that there is adequate change.

- Reconcile till roll and cash amount, and noting discrepancies.

- Recount cash in office and confirm discrepancies

The Lunchtime Assistant is responsible for:

- Assisting in securing the safety and welfare of pupils during lunchtimes.

- Undertaking the supervision and control of pupils in the dining room.

- Undertaking the supervision and control of pupils in the playground and other school areas.

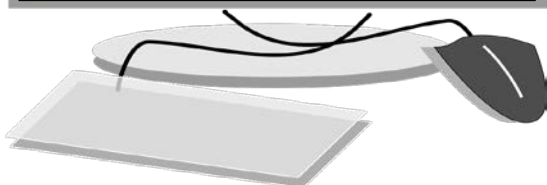
