A few reminders

Time of Arrival

Children in Nursery are expected to be seated in their groups at 8:40am. This is when the doors will close.

For all other children, registration is at 8:50am. This is when the doors will close.

If the doors are closed, your child will need to come to the office to be signed in. This is very important, so that all children are accounted for, and texts are not sent out in error.



Absence

If your child is going to be absent, please ring every day to inform the office of the reason for absence, and over



time to let them know how your child is progressing.

Telephone Numbers and e-mail addresses

In the event of the school needing to make contact, it is vital that the office has up-to-date contact details for each parent and if possible an additional friend or relative.

As we move towards becoming paperless, please ensure that we have an email address so that you can remain informed of activities and events at Lynch Hill.

Uniform

Please ensure that all items of clothing are labelled, especially outdoor clothing as we move towards the colder weather. When the lost property box is emptied, labelled items can be returned to the children rather than being disposed of.

Parking

It is against the rules to park on the yellow lines outside of the school, even if it is just for your child to climb out of the car. It is very dangerous, causes traffic jams to form and the police could issue you with a ticket for causing an obstruction to either other traffic or pedestrians.


