Current Weather

To keep safe in the sun, seek shade to cool down and keep hydrated with plenty of cool fluids, especially when out and about.



Top advice for being sun safe:

- try to keep out of the sun between 11am & 3pm
- wear UV sunglasses, preferably wraparound, to reduce UV exposure to the eyes, walk in the shade, apply sunscreen of at least SPF15 with UVA protection, and wear a hat and light scarf. Wear light, loose-fitting cotton clothes. This should minimise the risk of sunburn.
- drink lots of cool drinks and when travelling ensure you take water with you
- look out for others, especially vulnerable groups such as older people, young children and babies and those with serious illnesses
- never leave anyone in a closed, parked vehicle, especially older people, infants, young children or animals.
