## Parking and Waiting Regulations



This sign outside our school, tells you that during the times indicated you **cannot wait or even stop momentarily** to drop off or pick up passengers, according to the UK Highway Code.

In conjunction with the yellow zig-zag lines, penalty Charge Notices can be issued to motorists who do not conform to the rules and they are quite specific- even to pick up or drop off children at school!

Tickets are issued on the grounds of causing an obstruction to either other motorists or pedestrians and not for parking on the yellow zig zag lines directly.

**Please try to be considerate of other road users.**

Also in regards to parking, please ensure that consideration is shown to local residents; try not to park across their drives or drop-down curbs, and park entirely on the road with no wheels on the pavement causing an obstruction to pedestrians.
