**Independence- 'Are you ready for the day?'**

We are encouraging the children to be independent. As such, they must remember everything that they need; the office will not be making calls home for - PE kit (there is spare available)

- lunches (they will need to have a school dinner & receive meal debt)
- or Homework

In Years 1 to 6, each morning the children should be taking their folders out of their bags so that staff can check the contents, and at the end of the day they should ensure that they have all they need before they go home. (In years 1 and 2, staff will put items to go home into the folders.)

**Medical**

The following is a brief explanation of important systems. When a child is sent to the medical room, our well-trained and qualified medical staff will assess the injuries. Often an ice pack, a plaster or a wipe is sufficient. These cases are recorded, but no further action is taken.

If a child has bumped their head but the injury does not appear to be serious, a text will be sent to parents and the class monitors the child closely. We will only call home for bumped heads and other injuries that we think parents need to be made aware of.



**Hair Accessories**


Please be reminded that the school uniform policy states that only plain hairbands, clips and ties can be worn. Children will be asked to remove excessively large, or inappropriate accessories.

**School Photographs**



**Cars outside the school**

Please be aware that you should not be parking on the yellow zig-zag lines outside the school. It is also not appropriate to stop in the middle of the road for your child to exit the car; it is dangerous for you child, the cars behind you, and causes traffic congestion on the road.

**Please** sign up for Free School Meals if you are eligible.

We are beginning to book our trips for the remainder of this year and have found that one place offer BIG discounts if our free school meal eligibility is over a certain percentage. We missed out by just 1.3%! It would make all the difference to so many families if everyone eligible could sign up – especially families in Reception to Year 2.
