This means that the children are gaining an understanding of the importance of not sitting for longer than periods of 20 minutes at a time and how standing is shown to be much better for our health.

Our sedentary lifestyles are doing us more harm than we ever realised. After just 20 minutes sitting down, our muscles begin to shut down and our bodies begin to undergo changes that could have serious long-term repercussions and changes that are made at a young age tend to become habit.

We are therefore delighted to be one of the first schools to undertake this new programme designed to encourage our pupils to reduce sitting time by adding some activity into the everyday routine of the school.
