On Monday 26th September, there will be a French-themed lunch and 'pains au chocolat' will be available as an extra item on the break- time menu at 30p each.

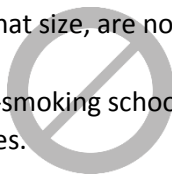
