At breaktime and lunchtime there will be cakes on sale in 5A. **(Donations of cakes on the day would be greatly appreciated.)**

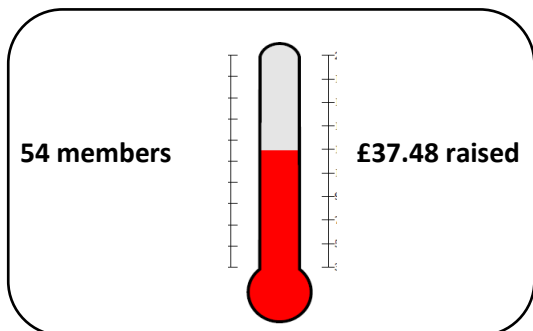
### Can you help Year 1?
