

Lynch Hill School Reading Questions

As your child's reading skill develops, it becomes more than just decoding the words and reading the story. It involves understanding the story and thinking about what happens between the lines. There are a few ways you help your child develop their comprehension. Below are some questions you can ask them (based on Bloom's Taxonomy)

- How did they use description to show how the character is feeling?
- Can you explain why...?
- Do you like the way the story ended?
- Who are the main characters?
- Where/ when did this story take place?
- What was your favourite part of the book? Why?
- What do you think could be better about this story?
- Can you think of any other stories that are similar to this one?
- How would you feel if the events in the book happened to you?
- What do you think will happen next?
