

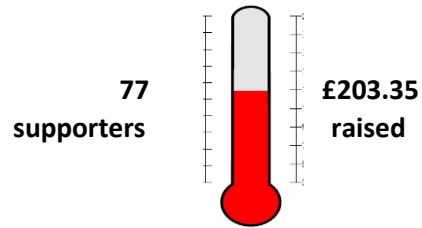
Take Care
